## Three types of E-Portfolios:

- Developmental- records the thoughts and actions of the user over a certain time to show a change in behavior or learning.
- Reflective- provides the user with a platform to post items and then comment on the nature of the item and how it relates to the user's personal development.
- Representational- shows the achievements and successes of the user in relation to a specific subject.
